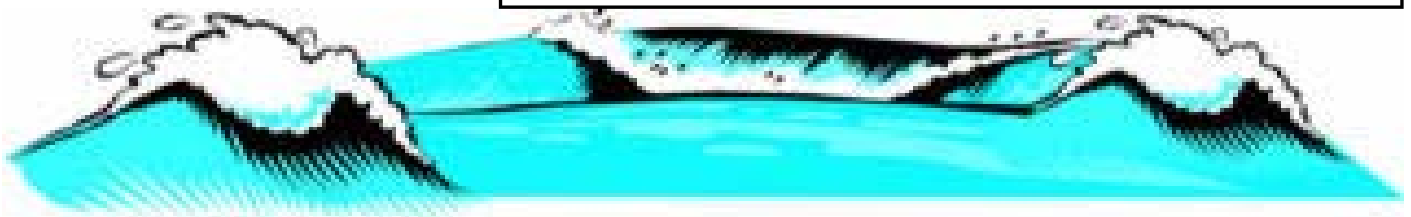

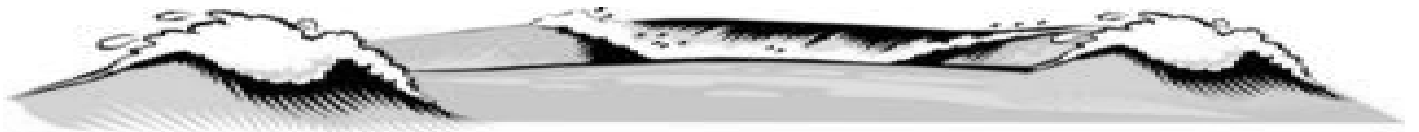

### CAPTAIN'S NOTES

There are well established rules governing which boat must "give way" when boats approach one another. The list below ranks boats from most privileged to the least privileged. Number 1 is most privileged and so forth.

1. A vessel being overtaken is most privileged. All vessels must stay clear of any vessel they are overtaking.
2. Vessels not under command (e.g., steering malfunction) or restricted in maneuverability.
3. Vessel engaged in fishing.
4. Sailing vessels.
5. Power driven vessels.
6. Seaplane.

Note you must give way to a vessel above you on this

The next Board Meeting will be Tuesday, November 1st, 2005 at the Little Bard

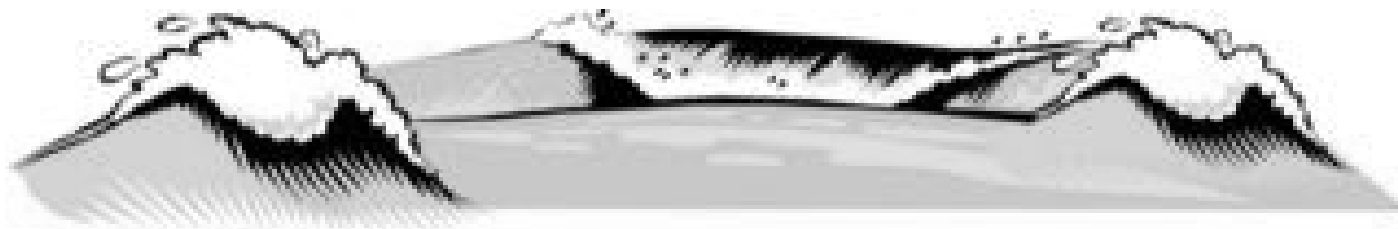
Commodore Margie adjourned the meeting at 13:30

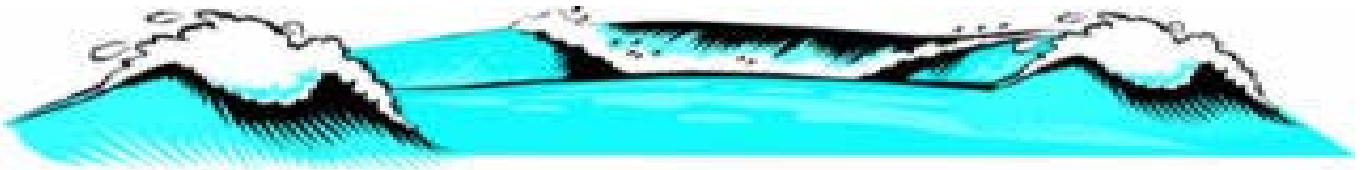
